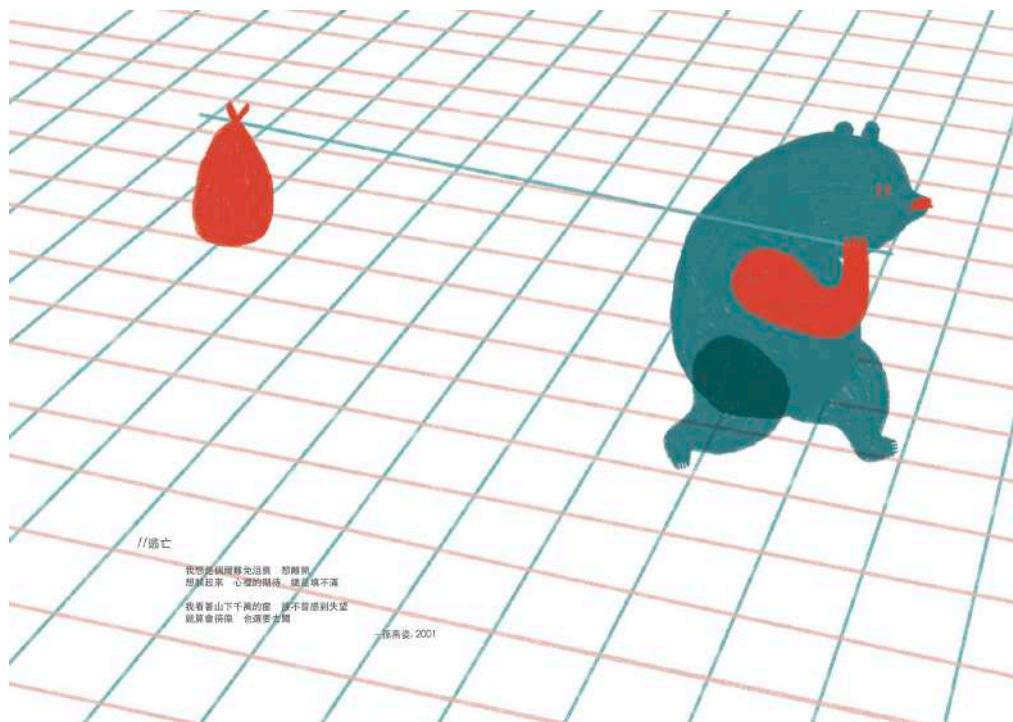


## The River

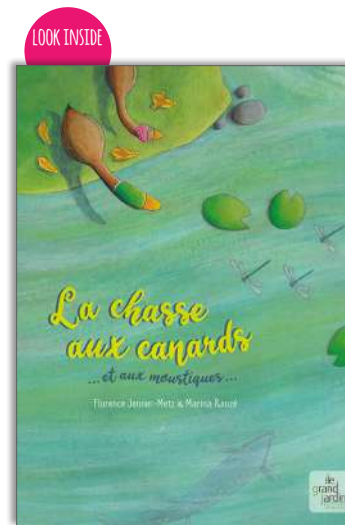


## Correspondences

## The Duck Hunt

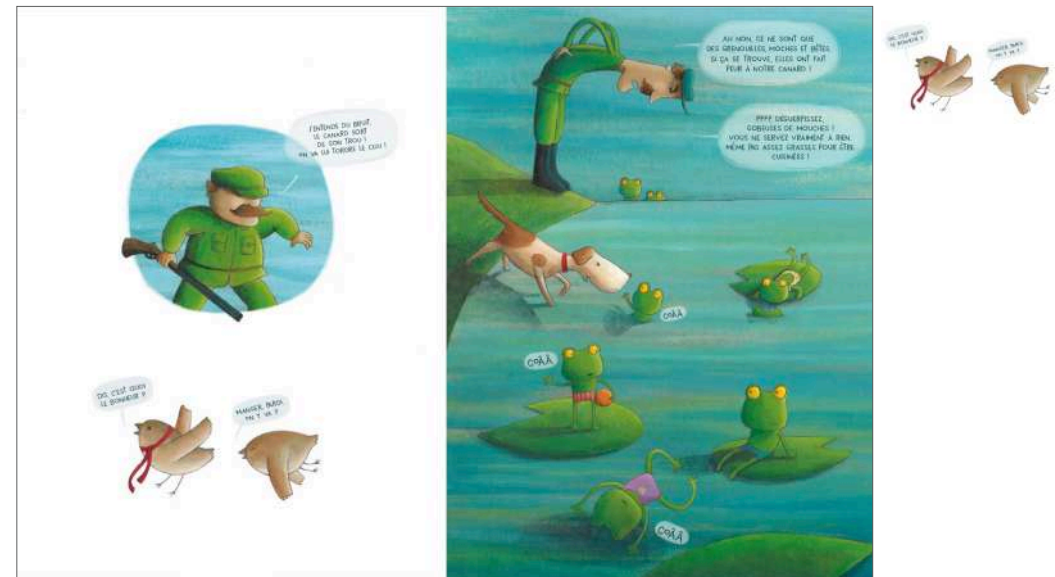

## Tell me, What is Happiness?

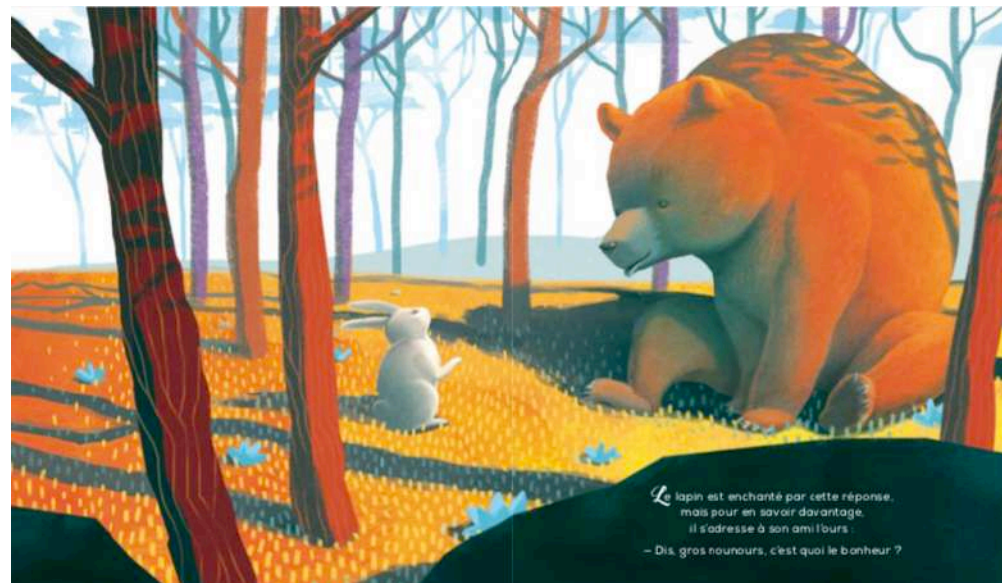

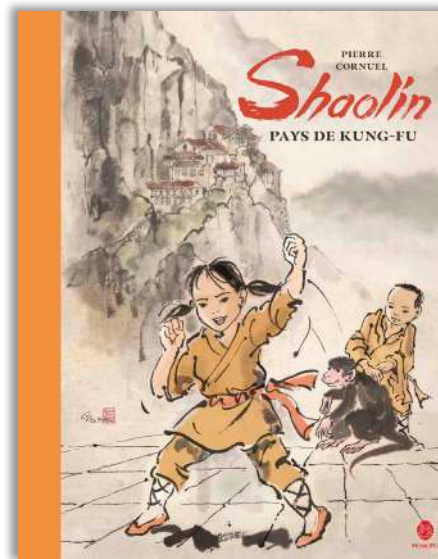

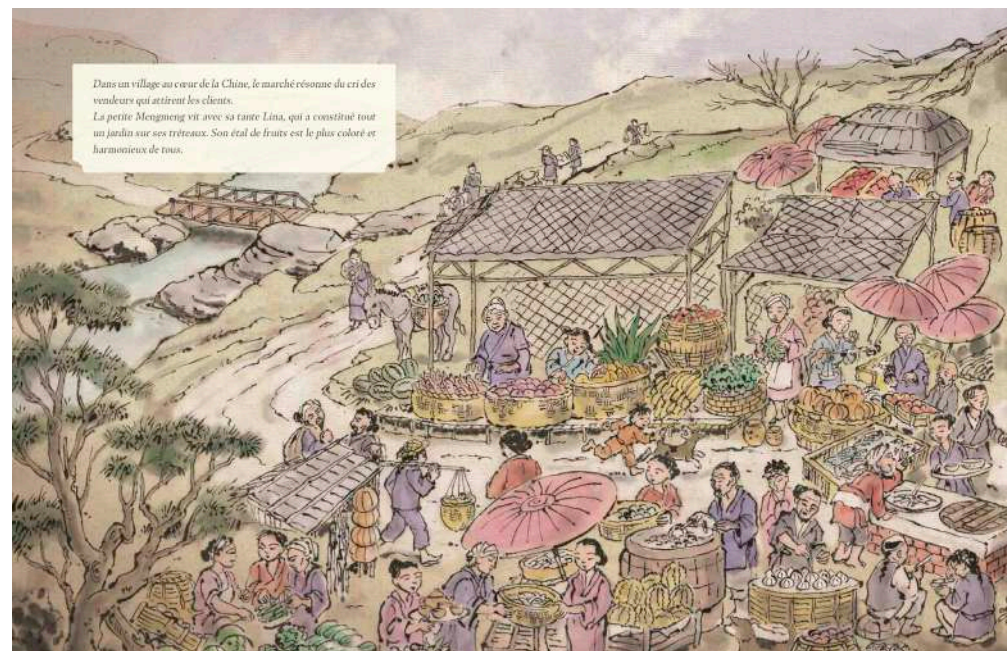


## Shaolin
