
Janvier 1923

notre petite ville de Pine Level, nous avions déjà compris que les Blancs pensaient que nous avions moins de valeur qu'eux mais tous n'étaient pas méchants avec nous. Ici les différences sont très visibles, les hôpitaux sont réservés aux Blancs, les Noirs sont soignés chez eux par des infirmières et pas par des médecins. Dans la rue nous n'avons pas le droit de boire aux mêmes fontaines. Je me demande à chaque fois si le goût de notre eau est différent de celle des Blancs. La plupart des restaurants refusent les clients noirs ou, s'ils les acceptent, c'est à la condition qu'ils disparaissent dans une arrière-salle derrière un paravent. Et pas question pour nous d'aller à la bibliothèque. Partout on voit des panneaux « Pour blancs seulement », c'est insupportable!

Pour rentrer chez moi je dois traverser le quartier blanc, et ce soir je me suis fait bousculer par un jeune blanc en patin à roulettes. J'ai répliqué en le poussant à mon tour, sa mère a pris sa défense. Elle m'a dit que j'irai en prison pour avoir fait ça et que j'y resterai jusqu'à la fin de mes jours. Je ne faisais que me défendre et une fois de plus c'est moi qu'on menaçait.

1928

À Montgomery, j'ai découvert ce que la ségrégation signifie. Les Blancs sont d'un côté, les Noirs de l'autre! Dans




Printemps 1923

Depuis hier, j'ai beaucoup de colère en moi. Si je ne veux pas que cette colère s'installe et me gâche la vie, il faut que je la dépose quelque part. Ce sera dans ce journal. Moi qui aime tant les livres et toutes les aventures qu'ils contiennent, j'ai pris la décision de raconter ce qui m'arrive d'important.

Hier donc, j'ai quitté la maison comme d'habitude pour me rendre à l'école à pied (le bus du ramassage scolaire est réservé aux enfants des familles blanches). Comme je passais devant l'école des Blancs, un garçon de mon âge m'a bousculée. Il s'est moqué de moi et m'a insultée en me traitant de « sole Noire ». Sans hésiter, j'ai ramassé une briquette qui trainait sur le trottoir et je l'ai menacé avec. Il n'en menait pas large! Il a vite compris que je ne faisais pas semblant et que je n'avais pas peur, et il s'est sauvé. J'ai reposé la briquette et j'ai rejoint mon école. J'ai eu du mal à me concentrer, cette agression m'avait rendue fureuse. Et j'y songeais encore en rentrant le soir. Tant de choses sont différentes pour nous les Noirs: notre école est toute délabrée, il n'y

Printemps 1943

Aujourd'hui, j'ai fait la connaissance d'Edgar Daniel Nixon, le président de la NAACP pour la ville de Montgomery. Il était autrefois porteur de bagages dans les gares. C'est un homme digne très engagé. Depuis peu, je suis devenue secrétaire bénévole de la NAACP. Nous ne sommes que deux femmes et nous sommes bien occupées. Je participe à toutes les réunions. Je prends en notes les échanges et les décisions. Je dois également collecter les articles qui parlent de la ségrégation et gérer le courrier.


Maintenant que je suis aux premières loges, j'ai encore plus conscience des difficultés à faire respecter nos droits. Je vois que la justice ne nous soutient pas beaucoup, mais je suis convaincue qu'il ne faut pas baisser les bras. Avec mes compagnons, nos seuls buts sont d'essayer de contester les pouvoirs en place et de faire savoir que les Noirs refusent de continuer à être traités comme des citoyens qui ne comptent pas.
