A political tale, this picture book takes us into a dictatorial universe where colors are one day banned. An album about politics and freedom, and why elephants have turned gray and unicorns transparent!

Wilbur III likes order and discipline. Since he came to power, he's banned the big market, had all the crooked houses razed to the ground, had trees cut down and ordered everyone to speak the same language... His latest idea is to eliminate the colors from the animals and the whole city: everything must be gray. So all the animals are repainted gray.

Offenders are arrested, and melancholy quickly takes hold of the inhabitants. However, one day, a young painter's cat puts its paws in paint pots and, roaming the town, makes the inhabitants rediscover color. This fantasy novel presents, via an alternating narration, an adventure mixing the living and the ghosts, offering a comforting vision of the afterlife. In the tradition of the Grand Jardin picture books, a beautiful object (with 4 illustrated cards) with a high literary standard. Josephine and her father move into Chanteperdrix. However, the old house is not entirely uninhabited. Édouard, a fifteen-year-old boy who died a hundred years ago, haunts the attic, where he is often joined by his friend Asphodèle, a tawny owl who can communicate with both the living and ghosts. Joséphine, no doubt as a result of her mother's death, discovers a special sensitivity to this invisible world and is able to communicate with Asphodèle, Édouard and other souls. They are all looking for Albert, Édouard's younger brother, but evil souls are also lurking nearby...

A beautiful story of bonding, mutual aid and courage, which takes a comforting look at the afterlife.




NINA'S PIANOS The life of Nina Simone told by her pianos by Sophie Adriansen & Chloé Mayoux

Before becoming Nina Simone, her name was Eunice Waymon. How did this determined little girl climb the steps to success? The pianos she played on join their voices to tell us...

The church piano is amazed: the pastor's daughter Eunice is moving rhythmically in her crib! The piano in the family home is amused: her feet don't reach the pedals yet, but Eunice can already play songs by ear! The piano of her music teacher is astonished by her talent, the one of the municipal library reminds us that segregation is rumbling, the one of the church with which Eunice accompanies the choir testifies to her loneliness, the one of the town hall where she gives a recital sees her demanding that her parents, who have given up their place to white people, come back to the front row... And the pianos of her high school, of the Conservatory where she fails the entrance exam, of the singing studio that employs her and of the bar where she takes the name of Nina Simone are still telling the story.

A life told like a tale, a rich documentary book that sheds light on the young years of a future legend of music and the fight against racism.

On a very tall ladder." But this boy will not follow in his father's footsteps, "Now I'm not an acrobat anymore. I tell stories. This one is mine and my father's, the man with the iron jaw."

Beyond autobiography, which happily invites one to question the history of one's family or friends, this very touching story also carries the reader into the depths of a reflection on predestination, because in this text, it is the hero's choices that guide his destiny and not family tradition.


THREAD AFTER THREAD


The two buddies spray them with insecticide and ward them off. Then, «the mosquitoes, in close rows, leave the pond without more ado»...




SUZANNE WITH THE BIRDS



CONFETTI CONFETTI




The tone is dynamic, light and the themes – tidying, pets – universal to laugh and understand a little more the parents' point of view.






MR FELIX IS HAPPY
