



He illustrated Paolo Mieli's books, and wrote, designed and illustrated *God Save The Queen* (Centauria). His latest book is *Breve Storia del K-pop* (Salani). His works are awarded and exhibited by New York Society of Illustrators, American Illustration, Creative Quarterly, Communication Arts, 3x3. 

A gallery of portraits of breasts that celebrates diversity, helps us accept ourselves and others, and opens dialogue about these parts of us under which our hearts beat.

From childhood to old age, this playful and poetic book presents, on each double-page, a chest with a word, leaving room for interpretation and inviting exchange and expression. Through meticulous work mixing collages, textures, and painting, Marion Cocklico uses stylized forms and bright, sometimes acidic colors to create a visual impact that is both poetic and graphic.

The text/image relationship gently highlights the beauty of diversity — relearning to accept, love, and listen to our bodies and singularities at every stage of life.



What we see everyday, when we look out of our window, when we go to school, when we walk around our city or town, influences us and plays a part in making us who we are. This book aims to open up a debate and offer points for reflexion, exploring an important theme that is the subject of ongoing research by science and contemporary philosophy, considered complex but which is in front of us every day.




Valentina Gottardi (concept and illustrations)


When one thinks of fishes, very often one's mind runs to the great coral reefs, the ocean depths or the polar waters. What emerges, however, is that fishes in rivers do everything they can to amaze us: some walk, some jump, some climb, and it will not be a rock face or a near-desert dune that stops them.

While it is true that many are famous, such as the fearsome piranha or the voracious torpedo, a whole host are virtually unknown, and many are probably still waiting to be discovered.

The bodies of these animals are covered with armoured scales and with mucus, a protection against infection. They are ready to do anything to eat and reproduce: this is how some of the most extraordinary migrations known to date originate, such as that of the eels from the European mountains to the heart of the Atlantic, with tens of thousands of kilometres travelled just to lay their eggs. The advice is not just to admire them in aquariums, but to learn as much as possible about them and, why not, to observe them close to home. A dense mystery navigates the banks of the river.



When the young man, nicknamed "Angel Face", wakes up from the brink of death, he is now a "broken face." After months of rehabilitation, he recovers. Once the war is over, he decides to resume boxing. "The bullet that didn't kill him may have made him stronger": now known as "Iron Jaw," he bulks up, competes frequently, sometimes loses but often wins. Until June 2, 1923, in New York, where his impressive opponent struggles to get up. Eugène Criqui is the world champion!



Frédéric MARAIS, a student of the painter Vera Braun-Lengyel, studied art history and graphic arts at the École Penninghen and the ECV (School of Visual Communication). He worked as an art director at an advertising agency before devoting himself entirely to his career as an author and illustrator of children's literature. With his characteristic restraint in writing and the brilliance he brings to his illustrations, Frédéric Marais enjoys exploring reality through the stories of exemplary lives, as seen in his picture books.

He received the Sorcière Award in 2016 for his picture book *Yasuke* (published by Les Fourmis Rouges).



Between games, reading, and visits to the chickens, they share moments, learn together, and create lasting memories. In the gentle rhythm of a summer day, the little girl begins to wonder: what will become of them? What will she do when she grows up? Will they always stay together?

Told in an intimate first-person voice, this picture book explores questions about the future, growing up, transmission, and memory, capturing the depth of childhood impressions through expressive, colorful monotype illustrations.






No! I'd Rather Fly to Space is the first picture book in the Series about Rusty the little mouse. This book is about bedtime resistance — and the transformative power of a child's imagination.

When Rusty's mom announces the evening routine — toys away, brush teeth, potty, bed — Rusty refuses. If he has to lie down, he certainly doesn't have to sleep. Instead, his bed becomes a vehicle for adventure.

First, it turns into a car racing through the quiet nighttime city, where Super Rusty helps construction vehicles finish building a house. Then the journey continues under the sea in a homemade submarine, where he explores glowing fish in the deep ocean. Finally, he builds a rocket and blasts into space — only to discover that even astronauts get hungry for breakfast.

Rather than framing bedtime as conflict, the book reframes it as adventure — suggesting that sleep itself may be the doorway to something extraordinary.

Rusty the mouse loves butter sandwiches and refuses to eat even a single spoon of soup. Soup is simply not a sandwich — and that's that.


When lunch turns into another standoff, Rusty's mom comes up with a playful solution: a color game. Every day of the week gets its own color, and only foods of that color are allowed.

Red Monday. Blue Tuesday. Sunny yellow midweek. Green Friday.

As Rusty dives into the game, shopping for colorful food and tasting new dishes becomes an adventure rather than a chore. One spoon turns into two, curiosity replaces resistance, and food slowly stops being the enemy.

By the time a new Monday comes around, Rusty is ready for a small but meaningful change — adding a tomato to his beloved sandwich.

The Non-Sandwich Soup addresses picky eating in a gentle, non-didactic way. There are no tricks, and no pressure — just play, agency, and joy.


Florian Pigé (author & illustrator)

In 2019, the album *Chut ! (Shhh!)*, text by Morgane de Cadier, won **LES INCOS AWARD**, CP category.



Returning from Egypt, the Emperor brings back to Paris a thousand treasures. Edgar Plantin, curator at the National Museum, is concerned: His Majesty demands an exhibition within two days. He must sort quickly, relying only on appearances. Exhausted, at the very last object he identifies... a trumpet. When the Emperor visits, he suddenly stops in front of the instrument: he wants to hear it. Panic on board! A throne, a stage, and decorations are improvised, artists are summoned. 
Based on a real anecdote from the history of art (the foot of an Egyptian censer mistaken for a trumpet, exhibited as such at the Louvre, which later served as the model for Adolphe Sax to create the famous trumpets for Verdi's opera Aida), Gilles Baum and Clémence Pollet spin a colorful tale. Rich with references to a flamboyant 19th century, it invites reflection on truth and power. At the end, a double-page spread with historical facts (with photographs) recounts the historical misunderstanding.



Gilles Baum (author)

Gilles Baum became a primary school teacher after studying mathematics. He discovered children's literature through a school project around an album by Thierry Dedieu. Dedieu later became a companion in his career, and Baum's texts reveal a strong sense of situation, narrative rhythm, and sensitivity in his approach to characters. Together, they created *Le Secret du clan* (The secret clan), published by HongFei in 2020.





One night, Jan Oksbøl Callesen dreamed of some zombies and some archers. 




These two distinct paths remain indissolubly linked throughout the book until they finally merge into a single, unified voice at the center: the moment of birth.
